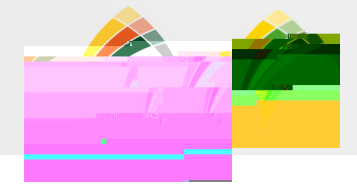

Definition - a person who pays a professional person or organization for services

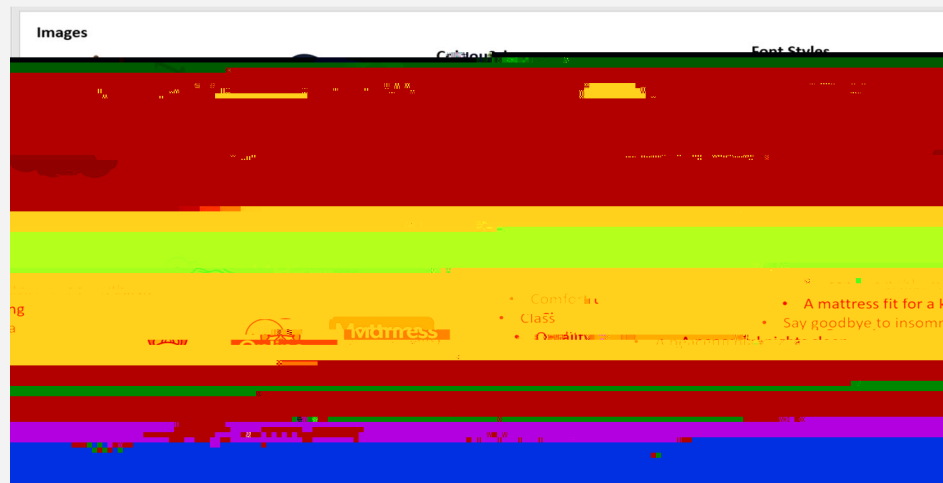
Associated terms: Customer, Person, Organisation, Meeting, Liaise, Service, Payment

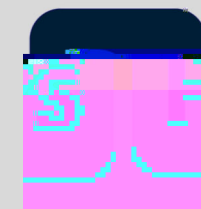
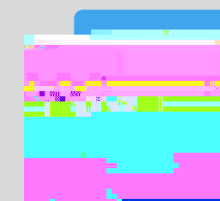
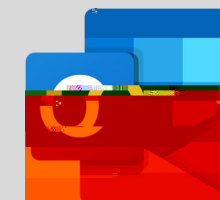
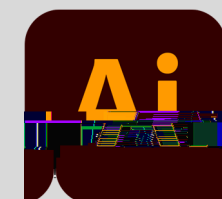
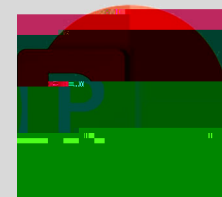
Definition - the program selected by the project developer to meet the needs of the project brief.
